ALTERNATIVE ARRANGEMENTS PLAN

Introduction

Sometimes the conditions at an event are such that it cannot safely continue as planned. It may then be appropriate to abandon or suspend the event or make other alternative arrangements.

Criteria for Alternative Arrangements

The following criteria will govern whether abandonment, suspension, or alteration of the event will come into force:

- Serious Incident
- Adverse Weather Conditions
- Adverse River Conditions

Decision

All incidents are to be reported to the Race Committee and the ERSA.

Weather and river conditions will be checked prior to commencement of the event.

During the event Umpires and Marshals will continue to monitor the weather and river conditions and report adverse changes to the Race Committee and ERSA.

The decision to make alternative arrangements rests with the Regatta Committee and the ERSA. The decision will be communicated to race officials over the radios and to coaches, competitors and spectators by public address announcements.

Action

Race Control will suspend racing as appropriate by contact with the Start Umpire and Boating Marshal.

All coaches, competitors and spectators are to act on the instructions from the officials and public address announcements.

Criteria to Restart the Event

The event may be restarted after:

- The safe conclusion of the incident
- A calming of weather conditions
- A calming of river conditions

Contact Details

The crew contact details entered on the British Rowing Entry will be used to contact the club.

Alteration of the event

Any decision to restart the event may involve the following alterations to the event:

- Restricting the event to specified boat types
- Restricting the event to specified participants
- Changing the direction or length of the course.
